

Data upgrade - Tax and Price calculation changes

Due to changes in our tax settings and price calculation, it is very important that you follow this guide directly after installation of the LS Retail .NET 2012 suite.


1 Which settings do I have?

First be sure if your system is set to calculate prices with or without tax. In earlier versions this is set on the price group of the default calculation store. How to find out:

1. Your default tax calculation store is set in the Store Controller. Go to:
Tools – Administration – Options – Store management
2. Press  which takes you to the **Store view**.
3. Open the **Price groups** tab and note which tax group has the lowest **Level**.
4. Then go to home view and **find Retail – Price/discount – Price/discount groups** and see if this price group has **Prices include sales tax** set to Yes or No.


2 If Yes, your prices are set **with tax**:

1. Go to **Tools – Administration – Options – Store management**
2. Press button **Upgrade price**.


3. Select **Yes** in the following dialog.




- Click **OK** in the message box that tells you how many prices have been upgraded.




- Now press the button **Recalculate prices**



- Select **Yes** in the following dialog.




- Click **OK** in the message box that tells you how many prices have been upgraded.



Now your prices should be calculated correctly from price with tax.


3 If No, your prices are set **without tax**:

1. Go to **Tools – Administration – Options – Store management**
2. Press the button **Recalculate prices**


